### CBI Related 1 - (1 credit)

CBI Related 1 is an academic course offering for students in grade 9 - 10 where the focus will be on "Life Skills". Some of the topics that will be explored are:

- Exploring Career Paths
- Finding a Job
- Success in the Workplace
- Dating and Marriage
- Consumer Skills
- Shopping Skills
- Using Credit Wisely
- Financial Management
- Balancing Multiple Roles in Life
- Health and Wellness
- Communication

## 9th & 10th

### CBI Work 1 - (2 credits)

CBI Work 1 is offered to all sophomores and freshmen in the CBI program. Freshmen may work only if pre-approved by the CBI coordinator and guidance dept. CBI Work 1 will be provided through the Brookfield Schools and supervised by the CBI coordinator. Students will work approximately one period each day in the district at a position that they are well suited for, and will act as a part-time job.

Starting in the 2021-2022 school year, students working in the district will begin the school year getting paid \$3.00 per day (tax exempt) with the possibility of earning raises during the year. Students are responsible for submitting copies of their pay stubs and monthly work schedules to the CBI coordinator for record keeping. \*All students who schedule CBI Work! MUST also schedule CBI Related 1.

### CBI Related 2 - (1 credit)

CBI Related 2 is an academic course offered to students in grades 11 - 12 where the focus will be placed on "Succeeding in the World of Work". Some topics that will be explored are the following:

- Thinking Skills on the Job
- Workplace Legal Matters
- Economics and the Consumer
- Banking and Credit
- Taxes and Social Security
- Finding and Applying for a job
- Interviewing for a Job
- Technology in the Workplace
- Time and Information Management
- Living on Your Own

## 11th & 12th

### CBI Work 2 - (2 credits)

CBI Work 2 is required for all juniors and seniors enrolled in the CBI program. All juniors and seniors are required to have a part-time job in the community working a minimum of 10\* hours per week. Students must have a job prior to the beginning of the school year Juniors and seniors are NOT permitted to work in the school district during school hours unless a special and unique circumstance exist and is pre-approved by the coordinator and administration. Students are responsible for submitting copies of their pay stubs and monthly work schedules to the CBI coordinator for record keeping. Students in the program have the possibility of early release privileges as well. \*All students who schedule CBI Work 2 MUST also schedule CBI Related 2.
