WHEREAS, the Board seeks to amend Board Policy 5771 at a single meeting to further its mission to prevent drug abuse among its students and in furtherance of its commitment to establish and maintain a drug-free school environment for the whole school community, and to use available resources to achieve this end to the greatest extent possible.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Brookfield Local School District Board of Education hereby adopts amended Board Policy 5771, *Search and*
